Referendum Question A


An Ordinance was adopted by the Mayor and Town Council of Kensington authorizing the sale of the property located at 3420 Plyers Mill Road, also known as Joseph's Park, as no longer needed for a public purpose. The property is to be sold for a use that is consistent with current zoning, which is for a single-family home. The funds resulting from the sale must be used to support a public purpose, with the expectation that they will be used to acquire other real property that will include greenspace for public enjoyment, growth of tree canopy and stormwater management, and will offset by at least 1:1 the amount of land that comprises the property located at 3420 Plyers Mill Road.




Dear Mayor and Town Council:


In March 2022, the Town passed a Charter Resolution that amended Section 710 of Article VII to state, "if the number of qualified candidates is not more than the number of seats to be filled, then no election will be held, and the qualified candidates shall be declared elected for the term by the Board of Supervisors of Elections at the next public meeting of the Mayor and Council."


In accordance with Article VII, "Registration, Nominations, and Elections", Section 710, "Conduct of Elections", of the Town Charter, it has been determined by the Board of Supervisors of Elections that the Town may forgo a formal election, as Conor Crimmins and Stuart Sparker, were the only candidates to file for Town Council for the June 2, 2025, Town Election.

Now, therefore, Conor Crimmins and Stuart Sparker for Council Member shall be declared elected by the Board of Supervisors of Elections at the June 3, 2025, Town Meeting.
