Maryland's primary election is **June 23, 2026**. There are three ways to vote (early, by mail, or on Election Day), so use this checklist to start making your plan. If you need assistance registering or finding a polling place, visit vote.md.gov/vote2026.

REGISTRATION

You must be registered to vote to participate in the primary election. You can register online, by mail, or in person at select locations. Maryland also offers same-day registration at polling places on **Election Day, June 23**.

- I'm registered to vote.
- I'm not registered to vote, but I will register the same day I vote.

If you're planning to register the same day you vote, be sure to bring a document that proves where you live. Any one of these examples can be used to prove your address:

- Your MVA-issued license
- ID card
- Change of address card
- Your paycheck
- A bank statement
- A utility bill
- Any government document with your name and address
