**Maryland State Board of Elections Launches Modernized
Campaign Finance Reporting Systems to Strengthen
Transparency and Efficiency**

Annapolis, MD (January 12, 2026) — The Maryland State Board of Elections (SBE) today announced the launch of its upgraded Maryland Campaign Reporting Information System (MD-CRIS) and Business Contribution Disclosure System (BCDS), delivering a major modernization in campaign finance disclosure, data accuracy, and public transparency.

The new MD-CRIS and BCDS platforms enhance how candidates, committees, and businesses report campaign-related financial activity, while offering Maryland voters faster, clearer, and more comprehensive access to the information that supports free and fair elections.

“These new systems represent a significant step forward in strengthening Maryland’s framework for transparency, accountability, and efficient campaign finance administration,” said Jared DeMarinis, State Administrator, Maryland State Board of Elections. “With real-time visibility, improved data accuracy, automated compliance tools, and easier public access, we are ensuring that our election processes remain secure, modern, and voter-focused.”

To support Maryland’s long-standing commitment to election integrity, the new systems were designed with both the public and filers in mind. They deliver improved accuracy and streamlined reporting for committees and businesses, while giving residents faster access to campaign finance information through a more transparent and user-friendly platform. The system upgrades improve staff efficiency and compliance oversight, reinforcing Maryland’s leadership in election administration and public accountability.

Specifically, the new systems will deliver a number of key benefits, including:
