Board of State Canvassers Certifies Federal and State Primary Election Results

ANNAPOLIS (July 23, 2026) — The Maryland Board of State Canvassers earlier today certified the 2026 Primary Election results for federal and statewide elected offices and presented the certified findings to the Maryland State Board of Elections (SBE). The certified election results are available at www.elections.maryland.gov.

This year marks the first time local boards of election utilized risk-limiting audits of voted ballots statewide. Enacted into state law in 2025, risk-limiting audits use statistical science to audit and confirm the results reported by tabulators with a high degree of certainty.
