Tomorrow is Election Day for Maryland's Gubernatorial Primary Election

Voters in Line at Polling Places by 8 p.m. Can Cast a Ballot

Tomorrow is Also the Deadline to Return a Mail-In Ballot

ANNAPOLIS (June 22, 2026) — The Maryland State Board of Elections (SBE) reminds voters that Maryland's Gubernatorial Primary Election Day is tomorrow, June 23, 2026.

Polling places will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. Tuesday. Voters in line by 8 p.m. can cast a ballot. A list of polling places is available online at vote.md.gov/vote2026.

Tomorrow is the also deadline to return a mail-in ballot. There are two ways to return your mail-in ballot. Mail-in ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by or before June 23. Ballots returned by hand must be submitted to a local board of elections office or an approved ballot drop box by 8 p.m. A list of locations can be found at vote.md.gov/vote2026.

"Whether voting in person or returning a mail-in ballot, June 23 is the final day to cast your vote in the primary election," said State Elections Administrator Jared DeMarinis. "Make a plan to show up, vote, and shape Maryland's future. And for mail-in voters, use a drop box to return your ballot today. Don't let the USPS changes in the application of a postmark disenfranchise you"

Marylanders who are not currently registered to vote may do so when casting a ballot tomorrow. They must [bring a document](#) that proves where they live when they attempt to vote at [their local polling place](#).
