### Maryland State Board of Elections Issues Latest Tally of Mail-in Ballots Yet to Be Counted

**ANNAPOLIS (Nov. 5, 2020)** – The Maryland State Board of Elections issued the following spreadsheet reporting the total number of mail-in ballots still to be counted. Timely submitted mail-in ballots will be accepted until November 13, so it is anticipated the totals included in this report will change between now and the November 13 deadline to accept mail-in ballots postmarked no later than November 3.

Presently, 87 percent of requested mail-in ballots have been returned to local boards of elections. This represents an increase from 77.5 percent in 2018 and 78.6 percent in 2016.
