Prince George's County to Hold Special Primary Election ahead of November's 2024 Presidential Election

ANNAPOLIS (July 9, 2024) – The Prince George's County Council announced that the county will hold a special primary election for a Council Member-At-Large seat on August 6, 2024, and that the general election will be combined on the State ballot for the 2024 Presidential election on November 5, 2024.

The Primary Election will be a vote-by-mail election whereby all registered, eligible Prince George's County voters will be automatically mailed a ballot. They do not have to request a ballot. Voters who have not yet registered and who wish to vote in the special primary must do so by July 16. Ballots will begin to be mailed around July 23.

If a voter is on the permanent absentee ballot list for all elections AND they request their permanent absentee ballot be delivered via the web, their ballot will be delivered via the web. All other voters will receive their ballots in the regular postal mail. Any voter can request web delivery by completing a mail-in ballot application at <https://elections.maryland.gov/voting/absentee.html>.

If a voter does not wish to vote by mail, they can visit an early voting center between July 31-August 5 to cast a regular ballot. Hours of voting from July 31 through August 3 are 10 a.m. until 8 p.m. On Sunday, August 4, hours of voting will be from 12 p.m. until 6 p.m. Monday, August 5 hours of voting will be 10 a.m. until 8 p.m. If the voter has already returned a voted mail-in ballot, they will be required to vote a provisional ballot. The Special Primary Day election on August 6 will have in-person voting at all of the designated early voting locations listed above from 7a.m. until 8 p.m. If the voter has already returned a voted mail-in ballot, they will be required to vote a provisional ballot.

On Election Day, the Prince George’s County Board of Elections will begin to conduct the mail-in ballot canvass. The provisional ballot canvass will be held on Wednesday, August 14 and the final day of mail-in ballot canvass will be held on Friday, August 16.
