



# Maryland Voter Registration

## There are three ways to register to vote

### 1. Register online

You can also go online to register to vote.

Go to: [vote.md.gov/VoterApply](https://vote.md.gov/VoterApply) or scan the QR code

Mail-in applications available in español, français, 中文 and 한국어.



Large type Voter Registration Applications are available upon request to your County Board of Elections or State Board of Elections.

### 2. Mail in a voter registration application

#### What can I use this form for?

- To register to vote in federal, state, county, and municipal elections in Maryland.
- To change your name, address, or party affiliation.

### 3. Register to vote during early voting or on election day.

Go to an early voting center in the county where you live during early voting, or go to your assigned election day polling place and bring a document that proves where you live.

## Maryland voter registration form instructions

### How do I complete this form?

1. Complete Sections 1–8 of the Voter Registration Application,
2. If you need to submit a name change or address change also complete Section 10.
3. Sign and date Section 9.

This form must be completed in black ink.

### How do I submit this form?

1. Tear off this panel at the dotted line
2. Mail your completed application to your County Board of Elections. The mailing addresses are listed on the back panel.



- Do not fax or email the form because it requires an original signature.
- Submitting the Statewide VRA to an individual other than an official, employee, or agent of a local board does not assure that the form will be filed or filed timely

### What is the deadline to mail in my application?

To be eligible to vote in the next election, you must mail your application at least 21 days before election day.

### What can I expect after I submit my application?

If your application is complete and you qualify, you will get a Voter Notification Card in the mail.

### Do I need to pick a political party?

- You only need to choose a party if you want to vote in that party's primary, caucus, or convention.
- If you do, check one box only.

### Confidentiality

- Except for items specified as confidential, voter registration records are generally available to the public.
- If you decide not to register to vote, that choice stays confidential. This information is only used for voter registration purposes.
- If you do register, the name of the office where you turned in your application will stay confidential.

### Am I eligible to vote?

To register to vote you must be:

- a U.S. citizen
- a Maryland resident
- at least 16 years old

You are not eligible to vote if you:

- are under guardianship for mental disability, or if you are, have not been found by a court to be unable to communicate a desire to vote
- have been convicted of buying or selling votes
- are currently serving a sentence of imprisonment for a felony conviction

### What information is necessary to confirm I can register to vote?

- If you have a current, valid Maryland driver's license, learner's permit or MVA ID card, use that ID number.
- If you don't, you must write the last 4 digits of your Social Security number (Election Law § 3-202). This number is only used for registration and other administrative purposes and will be kept confidential.

### What if I'm already registered to vote in another county or state?

- You must fill out Previous registration information (Section 10) if you are already registered in another Maryland county or in another state. We will then notify the appropriate voter registration agency.

### Use of your information

- This form collects personal information for voter registration purposes.
- If you do not provide the required information, you cannot register or vote in Maryland.
- You can update your voter registration anytime through your County Board of Elections or by visiting [vote.md.gov/Register](https://vote.md.gov/Register).
- Most voter registration records are public and may be shared with jury commissioners/clerks or other government agencies, as allowed by law.
- Voter registration records cannot be used for commercial solicitation purposes.

## WARNING

Giving false information on an application for voter registration is perjury, punishable by imprisonment for up to 10 years, and a violation of the election laws, punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000, or by imprisonment for up to 5 years, or both.
